Andrew Rogers, one of Australia's most distinguished, international, contemporary sculptors, works in remote and exotic locations around the world to create exquisite and exacting monumental Earth Art called Geoglyphs which re-connect indigenous peoples and places to their history, stories and ancient symbols

At each location Andrew works with the elders of the area to identify important cultural symbols and together they plan an artistic bridge in the form of Earth Art to provide the present generation with a frame of reference to an important symbol from their past. Local pride is developed through the teamwork required to create a lasting piece of historical artwork.

Coloured by local history, archaeology, dance, music, ceremony and a twist of adventure, this series takes the viewer to exotic locations with panoramic vistas and new challenges in each project.

Sri Lanka

It's hot and humid, the rain has just washed the roads away, and Andrew Rogers and his team have just 12 days to create three monumental Geoglyphs in Sri Lanka. Andrew works with over 1,000 stone masons across 3 sites, to create Pride The Lion, The Rhythms of Life, and Ratio, the temple stairs leading to the heavens. Pride the Lion represents the national symbol of Sri Lanka, and mythology from the time India and Sri Lanka were joined. Ratio represents the religious temples of the area, leading upwards to the sky, and Rhythms of Life is Andrew's signature piece. (23 minutes)

Bolivia

Potosí in Bolivia is the highest city in the world and it is here that Andrew Rogers attempts to make the highest outdoor sculptural exhibition in the world. The air is thin and the mountains very rocky and difficult to build on, and faulty surveying equipment causes endless headaches. At one point there are over 1,500 people working across the three sites. When the last rock has been placed, the celebrations begin and over 2,000 local townspeople turn out on the site dressed in colourful local dress to celebrate the creation of these significant earth artworks that can be seen from all around Potosi. Australia

Australia carries a rich tapestry of storylines across its vast continent, which indigenous peoples are striving hard to retain and pass onto the current

generation. Andrew Rogers discusses the dreamtime and the importance of these stories with Aboriginal elder, Jida who recounts the story of "Bunjil the wedge tail eagle" and why it needs to be remembered. After talking with the locals, measuring dimensions, and sorting the materials he will need to create an Earthworks series, sites are chosen a few kilometres apart, one by the side of the lake in the city of Geelong and the other in the outer hills of the Yu Yang ranges. But the local quarry does not have enough small stones to create the earth artworks as planned and the project lies in the balance until more people and machinery are found to help place the large boulders to finish the work. Iceland

Andrew Rogers has been invited to Akureyri to create a series of Earth Artworks to preserve Iceland's ancient Celtic/Viking mythology. Along with his signature Rhythms of Life piece, Andrew will create a large Nordic Eagle, which appears on the Seal of Iceland, and a Nordic Rune symbol which means NOW. Both have significant meaning that reaches back into an Icelandic Folktale "The Guardian Spirits of Iceland". The winter chill has arrived early and the sites begin to get frosty and dangerously slippery with rolling mists, unexpected snow and unpredictable intermittent rivers providing major planning challenges. China

Jia Yu Guan, in the Gobi Desert, is the site for three monumental Geoglyphs on near the western gate of the Great Wall. This will be the largest creation of earth artworks Andrew has ever attempted and will require over 1,000 stonemasons, 4,000 pairs of gloves, and thousands of tons of rock to complete. The three earth artworks will include Andrew's signature piece, The Rhythms of Life with a span of 200metres x 200 metres; The

Horseman, an ancient image found in the Wei-Jin tomb dating back to the Wei (220-265CE), and The Caveman, an ancient nomadic man from a series of fresco's in the nearby Mogao Caves. Both The Horseman and The Caveman will be 100 metres x 100 metres in size. The Great Wall of China frames the picture as the stonemasons create a connection to a time, a place and people of long ago. (50 minutes)

India

On the steep slopes of the Aravali mountain range, north of Jobner in the Indian state of Rajasthan, Andrew Rogers sets out to create two monumental geoglyphs: his signature work The Rhythms of Life and a chosen work by the elders of area called "The Ascend". (23minutes)
