The Forbidden City

For nearly 500 years, up until the early 20th century, 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties ruled China from inside the ornate walls of the Forbidden City. Emperors lived within and seldom ventured outside, encouraging palace intrigue, and internal political power struggles were commonplace. (24 minutes)

The Hanging Monastery

The Hanging Monastery is built about a third of the way up a vertical cliff in the Golden Dragon Canyon of Mount Heng. The descriptive name of the monastery is "Xuankong", which means suspended in space, as are the pavilions of this monastery, which cling miraculously to the sheer face. (24 minutes)

The Terracotta Warriors



The First Emperor of China, Emperor Qin, decided to assure himself an easy passage into the hereafter by taking his legions with him. The site of Emperor Qin's tomb measures some 5 kilometres across and the terracotta army is but a portion of the treasures encased in its depths. (24 mins)

Shi Bao Zhai Temple

As it rests against a thirty-metre high rock, the stunning twelve story red pagoda of Shibaozhai is a miraculous feat, a product of extreme engineering and spiritual dedication. What makes this marvel unique is that it only has three sides and was designed to lean against the cliff for support. (24 minutes)

The Leshan Buddha

At 71 metres high, the Leshan Giant Buddha is the largest stone sculpture of Buddha in the world. The carving of the Leshan Dafo began in AD713 but even after 1200 years, the statue is fully intact. One major factor in its longevity is its ancient but ingenious internal hidden water drainage system. (24 minutes)

Mount Wudang

In 1403, Emperor Zhu Di summoned 300,000 craftsmen to build Taoist structures on Mt. Wudang, over the course of just 12 years. The grand Taoist architectural complex is the largest on any mountain in China. From the foot of the mountain up to the Golden Hall at the summit of Tianzhu Peak runs a sacred stone stairway. (24 minutes)

The Great Wall

Just like a gigantic dragon, the Great Wall winds up and down across deserts, grasslands, mountains and plateaus stretching approximately 6,700 kilometres from east to west. Construction on the Great Wall began in the 7th century BC and continued until the 16th and 17th centuries. (24 minutes)
