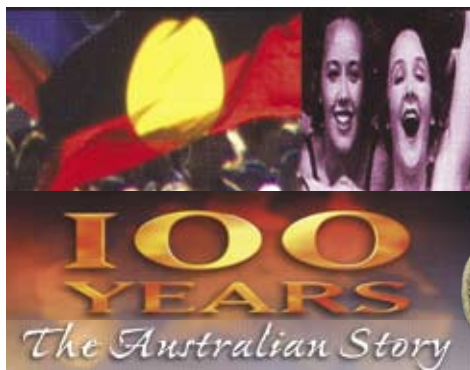

Episode 1

Child of the Empire

In 1901 at Federation, Australians created a nation within the British Empire. Australian nationalism and Empire loyalty went hand in hand. Our independence came slowly, often reluctantly and the 1999 rejection of the republic is consistent with this story.

Episode 2

The Rise and Fall of White Australia

Explores Australia's most startling transformation from a racially exclusive identity to a belief in cultural diversity. Australian identity was based on the White Australia policy - white was right. It took over sixty years for this central plank of our nationhood to be overturned and replaced.

Episode 3

Land of the Fair Go

Traces the founding belief of egalitarianism and the 'fair go'. The people of Australia looked to government to safeguard their lot. But when the world changed in the 1980s, Australia had to embrace a pro-market economy and reinvent itself.

Episode 4

Unfinished Business

A look at the history of policy and social change regarding Aboriginal peoples in Australia, including the 1967 referendum, land rights, the Mabo decision and the Reconciliation movement.

Episode 5

Farewell Great and Powerful Friends

Britain was the first such friend, based on the Empire. The United States was the second such friend with the ANZUS alliance. But Australia now negotiates its own way in Asia and the rest of the world.

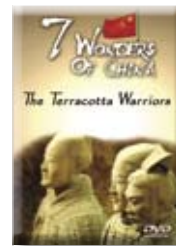

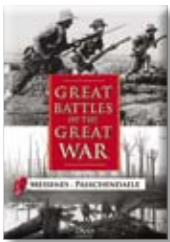
